Helping residents



With the number of council houses in the ward, a lot of casework is helping tenants deal with the council.

Mark and PJ have both worked with residents on housing issues. They have both helped raise issues about repairs, damp and mould, and problems with heating. They have also referred residents to the council's "Private Rented Service" to help with issues with private landlords. Most recently, they secured funding for the Welfare Rights Service for the coming year.

Play area action

Despite the council's promises, work has still not started on replacing the climbing frame in the Slatyford play area. We will keep demanding that the promised work is completed so that children can enjoy the facilities this summer, while continuing to campaign for better equipment.

Your FOCUS team is delighted that the paths are being redone on Ovington Grove. But that's only one street in the whole ward.

The council promised us that once the weather improved they'd be able to do a better job of pothole repairs. We will be following up to see what this really means for residents.
